The meeting also included discussions on strengthening teacher competences in the use of VR tools for training, and the COViR certification scheme and assessment tools.

The final conference, held on 5th April in Radom (Poland), included presentations on the COViR e-learning course and rules of certification, the Communication skills course, the COViR Teacher's Guide, and the COViR platform in the VR environment.

The day concluded with practical training in VR led by experts, in which they were able to interact in first person with the developed tools.

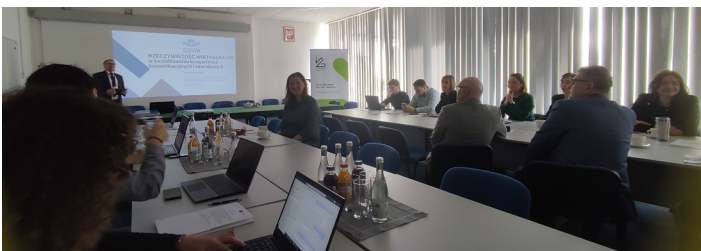
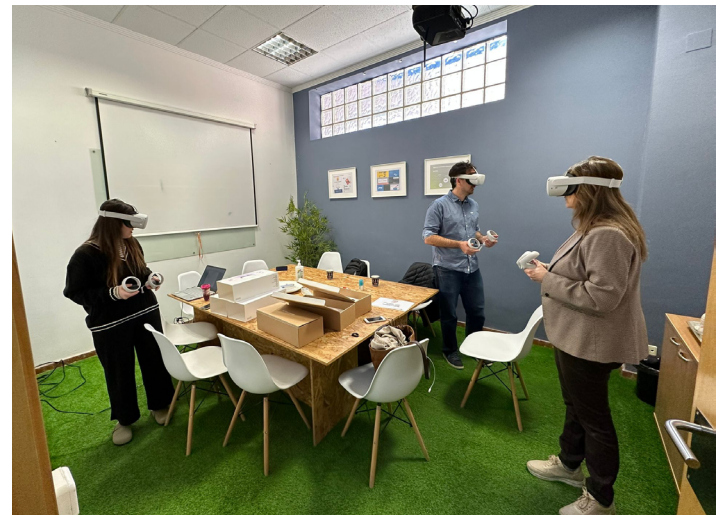
It is worth noting that our project does not end with the final conference - all materials developed during the project, including training materials and the e-learning platform, will remain available on our official website!
